Plaintiff, the Commissioner of Insurance and Receiver ("Commissioner") of Spirit Commercial Auto Risk Retention Group, Inc. ("Spirit"), and CANTILO & BENNETT, L.L.P., Special Deputy Receiver (together with the Commissioner, the "Receiver"), filed their Motion for Order Approving Final Plan of Distribution and Permitting Distribution of Certain Funds. The motion came before the Court for oral argument on December 10, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. Kyle Ewing, Esq. of Greenberg Traurig, LLP appeared on behalf of the

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Receiver, and Christopher Connell appeared as local counsel on behalf of Claimant Amy Garcia.

The Court, having reviewed the motion, the papers and pleadings on file, and noting that no opposition has been filed and that no party voiced any opposition to the Motion at the hearing of the matter, and good cause appearing therefor, the Court GRANTS the motion. The motion is granted for the substantive reasons set forth in the Receiver's motion and as unopposed under EDCR 2.20(e).

ORDER

Based on the foregoing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Receiver is approved, authorized, and permitted to make a distribution of payments on a 20% *pro rata* percentage basis from Spirit to those claimants whose claims have been allowed in full or in part, and assigned the statutory distribution priority class specified in NRS 696B.420(1)(b) (*i.e.*, "Class B" policy claims);

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the total available amount of assets available for distribution to Class B claimants is approximately \$15,200,000;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the total available amount of assets available for distribution to Class B claimants will be distributed at a 20% *pro rata* percentage based on the total Class B liabilities as compared to the estate assets available for distribution;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the SDR is authorized to conserve the remaining assets, in cash or in cash equivalents, for the payment of necessary additional administrative expenses and to maintain an additional contingency reserve for the continued administration of the Spirit estate;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon entry of a final order of this Court pursuant to NRS 696B.330(9), the SDR may pay from the above-referenced contingency reserve any Class B claims for which an objection or appeal is currently pending, and that such payment shall also be at a 20% *pro rata* percentage of the total amount allowed for the claim.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to NRS 696B.420(1) and due to the

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insufficient assets available in the Spirit estate, no distribution can be made for late-filed claims or for claimants assigned to priority classes lower than Class B (*i.e.*, NRS 696B.420(1)(c)-(l));

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Receiver may employ distribution procedures substantially in the form as those described within and presented as exhibits to the Motion and that such procedures comply with applicable Nevada law, and are within the authority granted to the Receiver by the orders of this Court and applicable Nevada law;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if any claimant fails or refuses to cooperate with the Receiver's distribution procedures, including but not limited to any request for data needed to meet Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services ("CMS") or other legal reporting requirements, the Receiver has grounds to withhold distribution of payment for that claim;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, absent the filing of any opposition by the United States within thirty (30) days of the entry of any final order on this Motion, the SDR's interpretation of 42 U.S.C. § 1395y(b) (the "Medicare Secondary Payor Act") as applied to Class B policyholder claims for reimbursement is affirmed and the SDR may proceed with its distributions to policyholders for approved Class B policy claims irrespective of the Medicare Secondary Payor Act;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Receiver's service of the Motion upon the United States (i.e., as set out in the Certificate of Service to the Motion) constitutes final notice to the United States, and all federal agencies and subdivisions thereof, of the Spirit receivership claims and appeal procedures, and of the requirement for claims against the Spirit estate to be rendered absolute (*i.e.*, both liquidated in amount and non-contingent) on or before the Claims Filing Deadline of May 31, 2021; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if within thirty (30) days of the entry of this Order, the United States does not file any opposition or bring before the Court any legal
